'Umbrellas' does not need an apostrophe as it is a plural.
- 2. B**
'Bolivia' needs a capital 'B' as it is the name of a country (a proper noun).
- 3. N**
There is no punctuation mistake.
- 4. C**
'Don't' needs an apostrophe for contraction as it is short for 'do not'.
- 5. E**
A full stop is needed at the end of the sentences after the word 'bike'.
- 6. A**
'It's' needs an apostrophe as it is short for 'it is'.
- 7. E**
The full-stop at the end of the sentence should be a question mark.
- 8. N**
There is no punctuation mistake.
- 9. D**
A comma is needed between the adjectives 'hot' and 'sunny'.
- 10. N**
There is no punctuation mistake.
