1. C

'Delivered' is the past tense verb for 'to deliver'. It is a 'doing' word.

2. B

'Seldom' is an adverb. It describes how often they walk.

3. E

The word 'difficult' is used as an adjective. It describes the 'decision' in the sentence.

4. D

'Fortune' is a proper noun. It is the last name of the MP and has a capital letter.

5. A

'Many' is the determiner. It determines how many 'friends' she has.

6. A

'Was' is a verb. It is the past tense of 'to be'.

7. D

The word 'at' is the preposition. It describes the position of the mother.

8. B

Pronoun. 'Their' is a possessive pronoun. The bikes belong to the brothers.

9. E

'Distinctly' is an adverb. It describes how they remembered. Adverbs often (but don't always) end in 'ly'.

10. A

'Yet' is a conjunction that joins the two parts of the sentence.
